



A guide to visiting the Santa Rosa Junior College Petaluma Campus

SRJC has been offering courses in the Petaluma area for nearly 50 years. The Petaluma Center operated primarily as an evening program until the completion in 1995 of permanent facilities on its current site. SRJC Petaluma was granted Campus status by the SRJC Board of Trustees and the California Community College Chancellor's Office in 1999. In 2008-2009, SRJC tripled the square footage of the campus with 7 new buildings and additional renovations.

SRJC Petaluma currently enrolls 5,600 students in credit and non-credit courses day and evening classes. Each semester students enroll in approximately 350 course sections in nearly 60 disciplines, including 30 majors and certificates as well as all of the courses necessary for transfer to UC, CSU, or to complete SRJC's general education requirements.

1 Kathleen Doyle Hall



Extensive renovations to Kathleen Doyle Hall significantly expanded Student Services areas, including Counseling, Work Experience, and the Tutorial Center. Classrooms are also located on both floors.

2 John M. Jacobs Hall



Student Services are located in Jacobs Hall, including expanded space for Admissions and Records, Accounting, and Financial Aid in the First Stop Center, *Our House* Intercultural Center, Disability Resources Office, and Assessment on the second floor. Jacobs Hall also houses an art studio, general purpose classrooms, and faculty offices.

3 Student Center & Courtyard Cafe



The Petaluma Student Center and Courtyard Cafe, formerly called the East Hall, was the former bookstore. Phase III expansion of the Petaluma campus added 2,300 square feet of expanded dining and multipurpose space adjacent to food service areas.

4 Carole L. Ellis Auditorium



The Carole L. Ellis Auditorium includes 5,100 square feet of space converted from the former campus library into a spectacular 256-seat lecture hall and cultural venue with extensive technological capabilities, including active distance learning and teleconferencing, cinema, small theater, and musical performance space with superb acoustics. The hall also has a green room, storage, dressing areas, and a ticket office.

5 Mike Smith Hall & Bookstore



The 6,000 square foot permanent home for the SRJC Bookstore on the Petaluma Campus was named for former Board Trustee Mike Smith. He was Board Secretary and Chair of the Legislative Committee for part of his tenure on the Board. Students and faculty may easily access the bookstore for curricular materials, supplies for the art programs, and essential items required by various disciplines.

6 Herold Mahoney Library



This magnificent 35,000 square foot building with a capacity of up to 60,000 titles, is located at the heart of the campus and is the centerpiece of the new eastern quadrangle incorporating the latest in information resources, learning environments, and technology. Facing Rotary Plaza is a Reading Room that provides a venue for expanded cultural and civic events that have become a hallmark of the library.

7 Richard W. Call Building



Named after a past President of the Board of Trustees, Richard W. Call, this inviting building serves faculty offices, an administrative center, and 18 classrooms and computer laboratories to support a wide spectrum of educational disciplines. Also found in this building is Student Health Services, Student Affairs, and the Writing Center to help students with writing assignments.

8 Physical Fitness Center

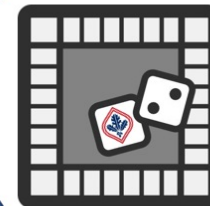
