Students must be taking 3 units (credit or non-credit) to be eligible for \$500 through this grant from the federal government. All students will be encouraged to apply and will be eligible for funding from some source.</p> <p>Syd Yang was the speaker at today's meeting. They are a healer/writer/counselor and did an interactive talk titled "Food, Bodies, and Liberation" and they talked about what our relationship is to trauma and food.
