

Centralization: ALL STAFF

(Terraliza)ion of all staff

- Headquarters at District level and no specific campus-based staff
- Examples: HR, Emergency Management, IT Help Desk
- How functions:
 - Requires management coordination
 - Requires remote access by staff





Centralization: Management (TYPE B)

- Centralization of management
 - Coordination level on campus
 - Examples: Facilities, parts of IT, custodial, now Media and Business services
 - How functions:
 - Requires extra coordination meetings
 - Bi-weekly all-management meetings (Extended PLC).





Centralization: POLICY & PROCEDURE,

Local Management & Staff (TYPE Centralization of policy/procedure and vision


- Dual participation: Department Level & Campus Level
- Examples: most of Student Services, Academic Support
- How functions:
 - Requires dual participation and communication at multiple levels


